Quick Install Guide

1

Download the Whidbey WiFi app on your mobile.

To download the app, your phone will need to access the Internet. We recommend downloading the app while you are picking up equipment in your Whidbey Telecom business office.

Select **Enable FaceID** if you already use this feature. If not, select **Maybe Later**.



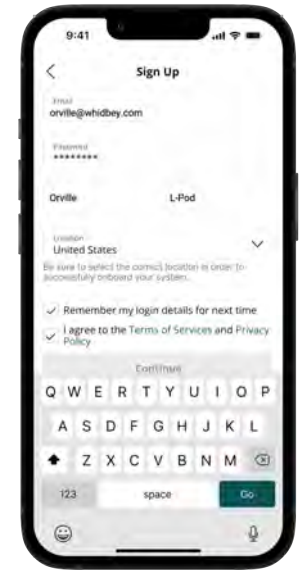

Type your email address and select **Continue**.

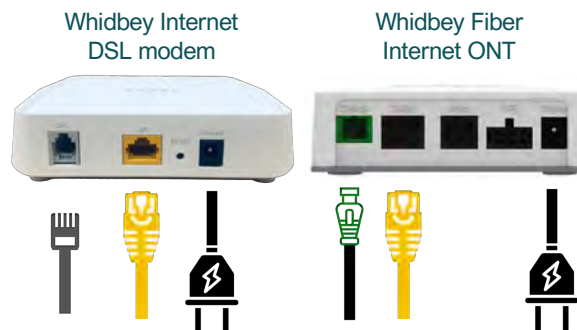
Enter your personal information, create a password for the app and agree to the Terms of Services and Privacy Policy.

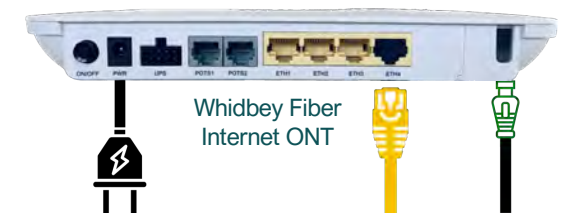
Please make sure the Fiber ONT or DSL modem are plugged to their wall jack and powered ON. The lights should be green or white.

If your DSL modem or Fiber ONT has only 1 Ethernet port, plug the yellow Ethernet cord there. The back might look like this:

If your DSL modem or Fiber ONT has 4 Ethernet ports, plug the yellow Ethernet cord into ETH4. The back of the ONT might look like this:

At the welcome screen, select **Set Up a System**.

When asked to give Whidbey WiFi access to the Camera, select **Allow**.

Attach the stand to router by sliding it into the slots until it clicks.

Scan the QR code on your Whidbey WiFi router.

The QR code is usually located at the top surface of the WiFi router.

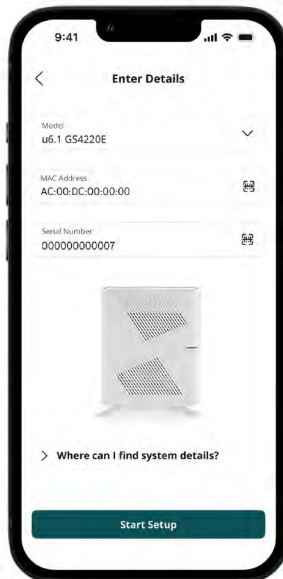
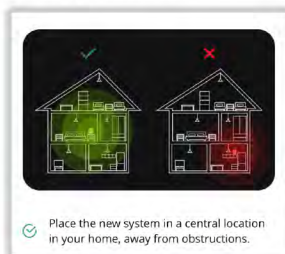

By scanning the QR code, the system details are entered automatically.

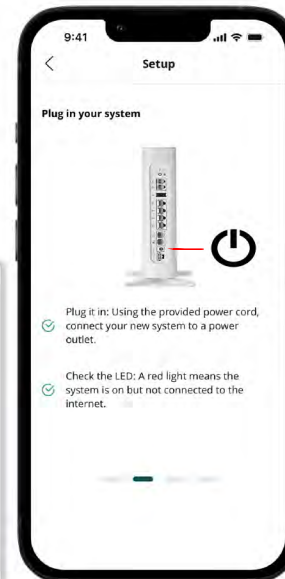
Select **Start Setup**.

Swipe left on the next screen after seeing the system placement suggestions.

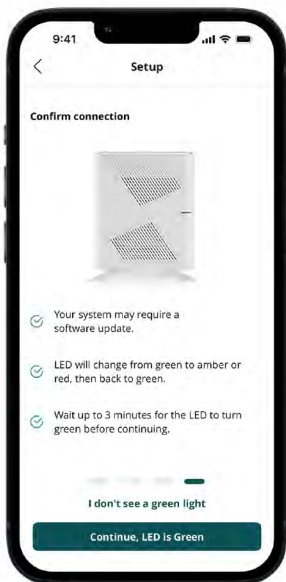
Follow the instructions on the screen, swipe left after each step is completed.

After plugging in the power and Ethernet cords, wait for the LED to change from green, to amber (or red), then back to green.

Select **Continue**, **LED is Green**.

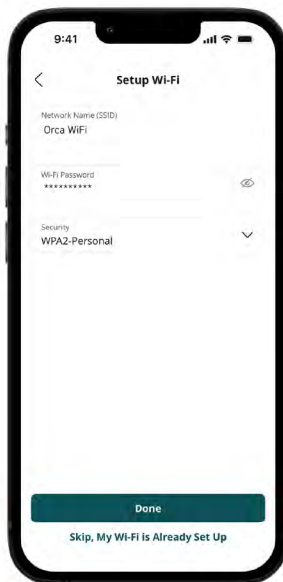

Create a name for your WiFi network, type it under Network's Name (SSID). Create a password and type it under WiFi Password.

Select Done, and now your WiFi is set up!

Mesh units are installed separately, Select **Not Now**.
